

Dear Parents and carers,

Thank you to everyone who responded to the questionnaires, some time ago now. We are delighted that we had parents/carers of 52 children in the school respond and that the outcome was overwhelmingly positive.

Of all of the parents/carers who shared an opinion, 97% said that they would recommend the school to other parents, 100% agreed that the school helps their child develop skills in communications, reading, writing and maths. 98% said that the school encourages their child to live a healthy lifestyle and 96% said their child feels safe at the school and is given ample opportunities at Foxton. 98% believe the school is well led and managed.

We, as Governors, are very pleased with the responses given in the questionnaires and are working with the school to improve those areas where parents would like to see particular improvements including disruption of classes through bad behaviour and ensuring that any reported incidents of bullying are dealt with effectively. As well as ways to improve our communications so they are timelier and to extend our offer of opportunities for children outside of the school day, beyond the sporting activities already available. The school will communicate this once they have worked out the best way to take forward.
